

The Wind Symbol in Luu Quang Vu's Poetry

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Abstract— Luu Quang Vu is one of the great poets of modern Vietnamese literature. In his works, wind is not just a natural phenomenon but carries many rich layers of meaning. Wind symbolizes freedom, the desire to explore and overcome all limitations. Wind also represents the constant change and fluctuation of life. At the same time, it expresses loneliness, the deep sadness in the human soul, and is an image of opposition, of internal contradictions in life, a symbol of the artist's soul, of creativity and soaring in art. This contributes to highlighting the richness in artistic thinking and the profound meanings of the wind symbol in Luu Quang Vu's poetry.

In Luu Quang Vu's poetry, wind is often described as a free force, wandering everywhere, unbound by any limits. Wind carries within itself the power of movement, of the aspiration to reach far, to overcome current limitations to reach new horizons. This is one of the important meanings that Luu Quang Vu conveys through the wind symbol.

In the poem "Wind and I", Luu Quang Vu writes:

"The wind sweeps me away forever To distant horizons

"Gió cuốn tôi đi mãi
Tới những chân trời xa
Tôi với gió làm bạn
Không còn sợ điều gì nữa."


In the poem "Which Direction Does the Wind Blow", Luu Quang Vu described wind as a force bringing change:

"Which direction does the wind blow Taking away old things Bringing new strange things But why does my heart still feel sad." "Gió thổi từ hướng nào Mang đi những điều đã cũ Mang lại những điều mới lạ Nhưng sao lòng ta vẫn thấy buồn."

Wind here is a symbol of change, of new things coming and old things going. However, this change doesn't always bring joy, but sometimes evokes feelings of sadness and regret. Life is a continuous flow of changes, and wind is the symbol of that flow in Luu Quang Vu's poetry. It constantly pushes people forward, but at the same time makes them face losses, things that cannot be kept.

"The wind still blows every night
Carrying secret whispers
Who knows what the wind will bring
Tomorrow is something no one knows yet."
"Gió vẫn thổi từng đêm

Ai biết được gió sẽ mang đến gì
Ngày mai là một điều chưa ai hay."





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Wind here is not just a natural phenomenon but a symbol of unpredictable changes in life. The wind blows through, carrying mysteries, whispers that no one can predict. This expresses the uncertainty of life, when people cannot know what will happen in the future. Wind is a symbol of instability, of unpredictable changes, but at the same time is the driving force pushing people forward, facing new challenges and opportunities.

2.3. Wind - loneliness and sadness

Another aspect of the wind symbol in Luu Quang Vu's poetry is loneliness and sadness. Wind, with its wandering, solitary nature, is often used by him to express feelings of loneliness, deep sadness in the human heart.

"Gió thổi về đâu
Mang theo những nỗi buồn không tên

Wind here is a symbol of vague, unclear sorrows, but makes people feel lost, not knowing where to go. Where does the wind blow, and people's hearts are also losing direction, not knowing where to find to escape sorrow. This is a haunting image of loneliness, of being lost in life, when people cannot find a way out of their negative emotions.

2.4. Wind - opposition in life

The northeast monsoon here is a symbol of harshness, coldness, but at the same time is an awakening, a motivation for people to stand up after failures. Wind brings coldness, but it is in that cold that people realize their strength, feel more sober, stronger. This expresses a profound philosophy in Luu Quang Vu's poetry about the opposition in life, that it is difficulties, challenges that make people mature and stronger.

2.5. Wind - the artist's soul

Finally, wind in Luu Quang Vu's poetry is also a symbol of the artist's soul, of emotions, artistic thinking. Wind, with its wandering, free nature, is an image of creative ideas, of soaring in art. Luu Quang Vu, with the sensitive and rich soul of a poet, used the wind symbol to express his artistic emotions and thoughts.

In the poem "Wind in the Soul", he writes:

"Wind blows in my soul Carrying unwritten verses Soaring ideas Like wings in the high sky." "Gió thổi trong hồn ta Mang theo những vần thơ chưa viết Những ý tưởng bay bổng Như cánh chim giữa trời cao."

Wind in the soul is a symbol of creativity, of artistic ideas. It is the driving force pushing the poet to write verses, an endless source of inspiration in art. Wind, with its freedom and soaring nature, is an image of an artist's soul, always seeking and exploring new things, new ways of expression in art
